Online Forum Seeks Community Feedback on Roe Extension

Dr Mike Nahan, Member for Riverton encouraged members of the community to provide information on what factors should be considered in assessing design options for the Roe Highway Extension from the Freeway through to Stock Road.

"The State Government is currently conducting a comprehensive community consultation process to establish the best environmentally sensitive functional design for the Roe Highway Extension," said Dr Nahan.

"The work is being coordinated through the South Metro Connect project team, which is made up of representatives from Main Roads and environmental and engineering consulting firm AECOM to manage the environmental approvals, engineering design and community engagement process."

"South Metro Connect is running an online forum throughout January to seek community opinion on what factors should be considered in assessing the design options and this information is vital for the next phase of the project."

"During the last State election, communities across the southern metropolitan area had their say on this important infrastructure project and overwhelmingly voiced their support for the Roe Highway Extension. I encourage the community to get involved in this project and to provide their valuable feedback on these important factors."
