To be eligible for the prizes, students must meet Western Australian Certificate of Education (WACE) requirements for secondary graduation.

Tertiary Entrance Examination (TEE) students must complete a minimum of four Year 12 subjects/WACE courses and achieve a minimum of three A grades and one B grade. Wholly School Assessed (WSA)/Vocational Education and Training (VET) students must complete a minimum of four Year 12 WSA subjects/WACE courses and achieve a minimum of three A grades and one B grade.

Alternatively, they can complete a minimum of three Year 12 WSA/WACE courses and one subject equivalent with a minimum of three A grades.
