Fun For The Whole Family At The Anzac Day Family Festival

Dr Mike Nahan, the Member for Riverton, encouraged all members of the community to come along to the inaugural Willetton Sports Clubs' Anzac Day Family Festival to be held on Sunday 25 April 2010 from 12pm to 8pm at the club's premises on Burrendah Boulevard in Willetton.

"One of the high points of the day will be the club's bid to beat the existing World Record for the most people playing Air Guitar – currently held by the Canadians at 1436 people," said Dr Nahan.

"I will be out there joining all the other budding musicians with our imaginary guitars or colourful blow-up guitars for a massive jam session to the driving beat of "Highway to Hell" by ACDC to help make history."

"I hope that the community will get behind this momentous occasion to not only acknowledge and honour Anzac Day but to help beat the current World Record at Air Guitar as well."
