### **ENES KAYA — PRIDE OF AUSTRALIA MEDAL**

*Statement by Member for Riverton*

**DR M.D. NAHAN (Riverton)** [12.52 pm]: I take pleasure in acknowledging the unselfish and brave actions of a year 12 student from Willetton Senior High School, Enes Kaya. Recently, Enes saved the life of Anthony Moore, a young blind man who accidentally fell between two carriages at the Oats Street Station in Victoria Park.

When the train pulled up at the station, Enes saw Anthony, who was using a cane, start to walk towards the gap between the carriages, instead of walking towards the doors to enter the carriages. Enes called out to warn Anthony, but it was too late. Anthony stepped forward into the gap and fell down onto the train tracks between the carriages.

Enes quickly rushed to the spot, grabbed Anthony's arms and pulled him out before the train started to move again. If Enes had not been there and realised what was happening, the incident probably would have had dire consequences.

In recognition of these actions, Willetton Senior High School has nominated Enes for a Pride of Australia medal for bravery. I join Anthony and his family, and Enes' family and his school colleagues, in commending Enes for his compassion for others and for his heroic action in risking his own life to help a stranger in need of action.
